HENRY STELLINGWERF

Henry Stellingwerf, 75, died at his residence in Wenatchee, Wash., March 16 following a short illness. He was born in New Amsterdam, Wis., Nov. 18, 1878. In 1904 Stellingwerf went to the State of Washington, settling in the Big Bend community where he and his wife homesteaded. In 1909 they moved to Wenatchee. Stellingwerf had been employed by the Fruit Growers Service as a refrigeration engineer for the past 20 years.
